Collections

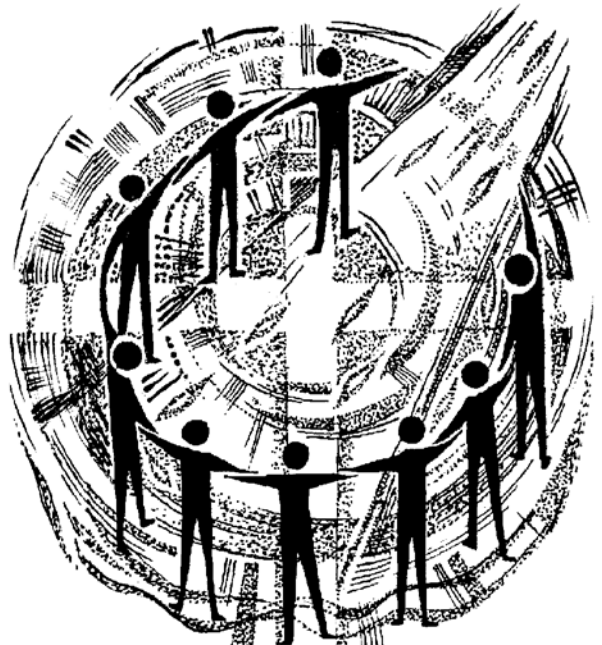

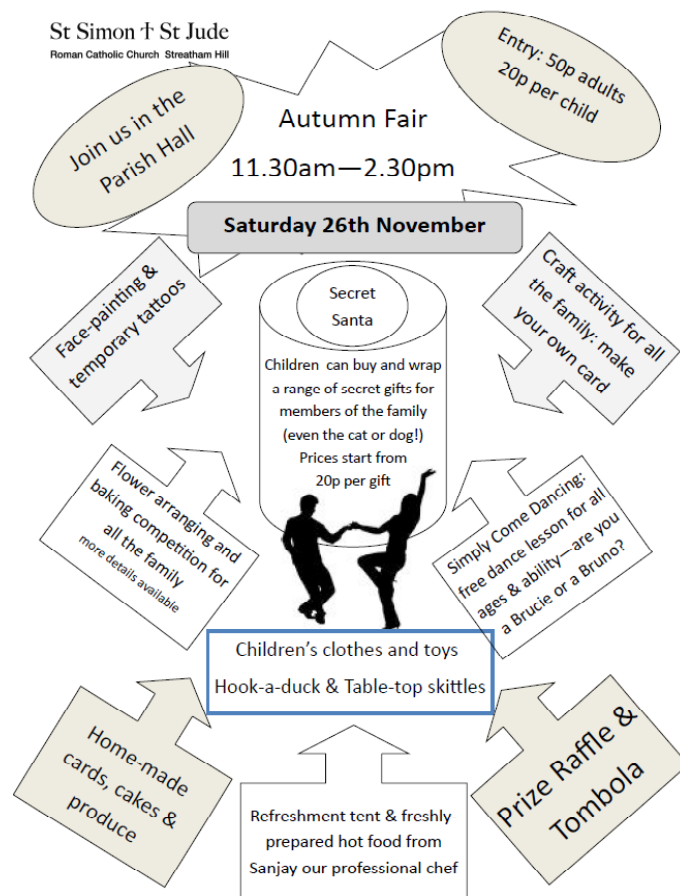
